




Outside Fire Pit Dimensions: 49" x 49" x 15" Inside Fire Pit Dimensions: 24" x 24"

## **TYPICAL CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE:**

- Determine the location and mark out the size of the square (49" x 49").
- Create a solid base by removing 6" of material within your marked square. Fill this area with 6" of compacted gravel and level.
- Install the 1st and 2nd rows of block on the gravel base according to Diagrams 1 & 2.
- Apply a masonry adhesive to cap blocks and install per Diagram 3. Allow 48 hours for adhesive to cure.
- Install the square metal protective insert.
- Fill the bottom of the pit with 3/8" or 3/4" crushed stone.

\*We recommend that after you install each course of blocks, you check to make sure the metal insert fits within the square.

## SAFETY FIRST

We want you to enjoy your Genest Outdoor Fire Pit, so please follow these fire safety rules:

- Build only small fires.
- Concrete can spall and crack if exposed to intense heat.
- Never use gasoline or liquid starters to ignite wood.
- Always tend to your fire and keep a fire extinguisher, shovel, and large container of water nearby to douse the flames.
- Supervise children at all times around open flames.
- Make sure the fire is completely out before leaving the area.
- To avoid warping, do not supercool metal insert.
